This is one of our most visible fundraisers and involves placing large American flags in the yards of subscribing families on flag-related holidays. The more flags there are in a neighborhood, the better it looks, so tell your friends and neighbors and ask them to subscribe! It also requires a lot of volunteers to make this happen, so please consider signing up for morning placement and evening pickup routes when the signups come out. Families can do this together and it counts for senior volunteer hours! We would love to have all

of our band families participate in at least two shifts during the summer. The first three flag placement days will be Memorial Day (May 30), Flag Day (June 14), and the Fourth of July. Sign-ups will begin on the night of our Fall Kick-off.



Another major fundraiser for the Band Boosters is the Williamson County Fair, August 5-13. The Page Band provides volunteers to man all of the entry ticket booths and in return receives a large donation from the fair board from a portion of the ticket sales. These evenings are so much fun and a great way to raise funds and spread name recognition for the band. This is another activity that requires an army of volunteers, and we would love to have all of our band
